A team of our teachers render dedicated services for the continuous development of the students.

CBSE

The school follows CBSE curriculum which helps in the all-around development of a child without any individual differences. The school professes its commitment towards providing education without any compromise. True education is the end of ignorance. The Dawn Public School is set to achieve excellence in learning while moulding boys and girls into responsible and compassionate citizens.

SMART CLASS

Mode of teaching is updated with the latest audio-visual technology. Audio along with visual images help students to understand the facts and ideas easily. The pedagogical concept attempts to break the monotony of a normal teaching process, through visual learning that promises to make learning visually appealing, interesting, and accessible with a 3D content that is user friendly and allows greater retention and clarity.

SCHOOL ASSEMBLY

School assembly will be conducted on every Tuesday's and Wednesday's. Two activities will be there in every assembly. The first one will hold educational values and the second one will hold entertainment values. The winners will be rewarded. Class teachers will be in charge of 7AM club activities. Apart from this, there will be a mass PT in the auditorium on every Wednesday's. Life skill lesson is a class-wise activity introduced in I to VIII classes on all Mondays in order to inculcate and develop basic skills and values needed for our kids. There will be a theme for each month. Themes include salutations, good manners etc.

ROBOTICS

This year robotics class was introduced in collaboration with Tinker Zone-Think out of box, an initiative by Ore Equipe for providing practical robotics class to school students from grade I to VIII. Introduction of sensor, automatic system and practical session for Line Follower Robot, Light Follower Robot, RC controlled car are included in the syllabus. Classes will be concluded by the month of March.

SELF DEFENSE

Our school have started the basic course for self defense from the month of October. 65 students are included in this activity, where the basic motive is to enhance individual to their discipline and responsibility.
